### **DATA ENTRY VOLUNTEERS**

We are looking for someone to work on data entry for next year's student directory. This is the perfect volunteer job for someone who is both a good typist and is comfortable working with an excel spreadsheet. You won't be inputting data for each and every student, but for those who need changes made to the preliminary data.

The first phase of data entry will need to be done shortly after registration (when we collect the bulk of the changes to be made). The specific timing is flexible, but somewhere between Aug 9 and 20 is ideal. Then there will be a smaller set of changes after we collect data from late registrants later in August and a very small set after school begins. (You need not be available for each phase.)

So if you've always wanted that "stay at home – work in your jammies – on your own time" – kind of volunteer opportunity – please consider this one. (I did this job last year, and I don't recall how much time I spent on it, but it was probably a few hours a day for a couple of days.)
