Parents of Seniors - Cap & Gown Orders Due January 15

- On January 8, seniors were given information from Jostens regarding cap and gown orders as well as other optional items such as announcements and rings.
- Those planning to participate in the graduation ceremony should order, at a minimum:
 - o a cap and gown unit, which includes a tassle (\$30); or
 - o cap and tassel (\$20) if they will be using an older sibling's gown
 - Other packages are available for those that want additional items
- Students should return the completed order form and payment to school on January 15
 when Jostens will be collecting orders and payment. (Payment in full for orders under \$75, for
 larger orders a minimum \$75 deposit is required.)
- The Jostens Order Form is a bit confusing a bit of clarification:
 - If your student needs nothing other than, cap/gown/tassel use section 4 of the order form
 - The Cap and Gown Unit includes a tassel and costs \$30
 - The Cap and Tassel Only, (no gown) costs \$20
 - To see what is included in and the prices of Packages A, B and C (section 4 of the order form) refer to the separate sheet that was included in the packet.
 - Handling fee is NOT required for students who order ONLY a cap & gown unit, a cap & tassel or package C from section 4 of the order form.
 - Students who order anything from section 2 or 3 of the order form or who order package A or B from section 4 of the order form DO need to pay the \$9.95 handling fee. (That is students ordering anything that includes something other than a cap/gown/tassle.)
 - All orders should add 5.6% sales tax.
- Students also received a diploma form which they should complete and turn in if they have not already done so.
- Your student should have hard copies of all materials. If they are missing any materials, additional copies are available in the main office.
- Please note that ceremony tickets are limited (usually 5 per graduate but the number is not
 "official" yet for this year.) You are welcome to send announcements to as many people as you
 like, but you will be limited as to how many may actually attend the ceremony. Look for additional
 graduation logistical information to come in February or March.
