#### **Athletic Highlights**

**Girls Gymnastics** – Lost to Whitefish Bay, but bettered their scores impressively. Varsity had an almost 20 point improvement while JV improved by 40 points. The girls performed well, Asia C had the highest score on floor and Erin Valusek had a personal best on beam. Gabby C-S. placed second on floor and Caitlin Nadar made her season debut and competed in all 4 events!

**Boys Swimming** – Won the 13 team Bulldog Invitational in Cedarburg, by an impressive 59 points over the second place team. The team scored in all 6 relays and 19 individual events. Highlights included wins by Kasmir B. in the 50 freestyle and the 100 freestyle, by Jay T in the 100 butterfly, and relay wins by the 200 medley relay team of Derek L., Jay T., Kasmir B. & Andrew E. and the 400 freestyle relay team of Jay T, Isaac F-M, Kirill K and Kasmir B.
