Parent Forum - Wednesday, November 20, 2013 6:30-8pm What is My Child Thinking? Understanding Adolescent Brain Development

Clinical Psychologist Brian Fidlin, PsyD, will speak about the impact the adolescent brain has on decision-making, risk-taking and emotions. Dr. Fidlin presents rather complex material in a manner that is unique, practical and entertaining. This forum is targeted to parents of $6^{th} - 12^{th}$ graders and those who work with adolescents.

The presentation will take place from 6:30-7:30 pm and be followed by a 30 minute Q&A session. Please note the location will be the lower level of the Shorewood PUBLIC library.
