College Financial Aid Presentation – December 9 – NICOLET HIGH SCHOOL

The federal form for financial aid is called the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). All families are encouraged to fill out this form regardless of need since some colleges use it to qualify the student for other aid and/or scholarships.
