There is also a spot on the Transcript Request Form to put the deadline, as well. Transcript Request Forms are located in the Student Support Office and can be turned in to Mrs. Turner along with the \$3 (cash or check) transcript fee for each request. Students are not able to request transcripts online and there is no way for the counselors to know if a transcript is needed unless the Request Form and money are turned in.
