If they are particularly comfortable with a certain subject area and motivated to do the work, this is acceptable – but they still must register timely.)

Wisconsin's Youth Options program allows public high school juniors and seniors who meet certain requirements to take postsecondary courses at a UW institution, a Wisconsin technical college, one of the state's participating private nonprofit institutions of higher education, or tribally-controlled colleges. Approved courses count toward high school graduation and college credit. Applications for Fall 2012 Youth Options Courses are due in the Student Support Services Office by March 1.
