Women's Assault Prevention High School through Adults – Program Offered through the Rec. Dept.

The Shorewood Recreation Department has a new program coming up. This program is for females in high school through adult who want to learn how to keep themselves safe and is ideal for a mother and daughter, a group of friends or to take by yourself. The assault prevention program "STRATEGIC WAPP (Women's Assault Prevention Programming)" will focus on building self confidence through teaching effective striking techniques, should a physical response be necessary. In addition, "STRATEGIC WAPP" focuses on teaching conflict communication skills, and analysis and proactive planning. "STRATEGIC WAPP" will keep you safe through assault prevention planning.

The class will take place on Saturdays from Feb 19-Mar 26 from 10:00 to 12:00 at SHS. Cost is \$200 for residents, and \$210 for non-residents. Michael Feinberg, Retired County Sheriff will be the instructor.
