College Search and Application Process

During the spring many juniors begin the process of reaching colleges, taking standardized tests and even going on a few campus tours. If you are about to embark on this process with your child, you may want to review the Parent Association's Guide to the College Search and Application Process. School Board Election – April 1 (During Spring Break)

Please note that the school board election will take place on April 1, which falls during spring break. Individuals can cast an absentee ballot if they will be unable to vote in person on Election Day.

Voting in the Village Clerk's office will begin on Monday, March 17 and continue until 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 28. Office hours are 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. If you have any additional questions regarding absentee voting, contact the Village of Shorewood offices at (414) 847-2700.

Absentee ballots will be sent the week of March 10 to all individuals that have previously submitted an absentee application. Application received in the mail after March 10 will be processed within 24 hours of receipt. Absentee Ballot applications can be found on the <u>Village of Shorewood Website</u>.
