

SHS GRADUATION INFORMATION

Graduation Tickets

- A. Commencement will take place **Thursday, June 12, 2014** at 8:00 p.m. Students must arrive by 7:30 p.m. All parents and guests must be seated by 7:50 p.m.
- B. Each graduating senior will be allotted a total of five (5) tickets. Extra tickets are not available at this time.
- C. Graduation tickets will be distributed at the end of the rehearsal on Thursday, June 12.
- D. If you have special seating requests/needs for family members, please see Ms. Schneider to make arrangements. All requests must be made no later than June 6, 2014.

Rehearsals

- A. There will be two (2) REQUIRED rehearsals in the afternoon during exam week.
- B. Rehearsal on **Tuesday, June 10 will be from 1:00 – 2:15** and on **Thursday, June 12 from 1:30 – 3:15**.
- C. **ALL graduates must attend both rehearsals. We will expect no excuses, so plan ahead. Clear your schedule for these dates and tell your parents so they don't make plans for you.**

Graduation Night

- A. Seniors will report to the **Studio Theater** (room 179, Auditorium Building) and be ready to go by 7:30 p.m.
- B. You must be dressed, lined up and ready to move towards the Auditorium Lobby.

Caps and Gowns

- A. If you haven't ordered a cap and gown yet, do so A.S.A.P. Please see Ms. Schneider if you need information.
- B. Student caps and gowns will be distributed, along with any other items you may have ordered, in the front hall of the Administration Building around the end of April. Announcements will be made. PLEASE open up the gown right away to make certain it fits and there are no problems.

Pre-Graduation Pictures

All seniors wanting to take pictures in their cap and gown may come to the high school at 6:45 p.m. This will be a great opportunity for your parents to get pictures of you with your friends in your caps and gowns. However, all seniors will start to file into the Studio Theater at 7:15 p.m. At 7:30, all seniors will be lined up and ready to go. NO EXCUSES!
