Athletic News & Highlights

BOYS TRACK TEAM WINS STATE CHAMPIONSHIP. GIRLS ALSO PERFORM WELL.

Twelve Shorewood student athletes, four girls and eight boys, recently traveled to LaCrosse to compete in the WIAA State Championship Track meet.

During the meet, numerous Shorewood athletes earned top individual and team finishes, including: a third place the boys 4x800 meter relay team of Charles Stahl, Jack Mauer, John Traudt, and Jacob Goldberg; a sixth place finish by triple-jumper Taylor Dennis; a fifth place finish in the mile run by Morgan Florsheim and a 13th place finish in the same event by her sister Haley. Both girls also placed in the 3,200 meter (2 mile) run, with Morgan finishing 5th, earning a personal best with a time of 10:55, and Haley placing 10th, also finishing a personal best with a time of 11:19; a third place finish by Charles Stahl in the 3,200 (2 mile) meter run; a second place finish by the boys 4x100 meter relay team, a sixth place finish by Alexis Farrington in the 400 meter race; a fourth place finish by Jacob Goldberg in the 800 meter run (Goldberg also set

a **NEW SCHOOL RECORD TIME** with his 1:54.1 finish); Alexis Farrington placed 6th in the 200 meter dash while Justin Rabon placed third in the same race on the boys side; finally, the boys 4x400 meter relay team of Alec Grimmer, Taylor Dennis, Jacob Goldberg, and Justin Rabon placed first in the race, **SETTING A NEW DIVISION II STATE RECORD** while giving the boys **THE DIVISION II STATE CHAMPIONSHIP, THE FIRST IN SCHOOL HISTORY!**
