School Supplies

SHS has posted a <u>school supply list on the website</u>. Classes without specific requirements listed will generally require that students have writing utensils and papers, but specific types/styles may be up to the discretion of the student. In addition, teachers may inform students of additional items needed at the beginning of the semester or as the semester proceeds.

Bell Schedules – First Week and Beyond

First Day Schedule: School will begin on September 3. Freshmen should report to their first hour class at 7:45 am (those with zero hour should report there at 7:35). After a quick run through of classes just for freshmen, all students, grades 9-12 will begin the day with first hour at 9:10 am. This allows freshmen to walk through their schedule and meet each teacher before the day begins with upperclassmen. See specific details on page 3 the <u>school newsletter</u> that was mailed home in July. The end time for the day will be 2:27 for most students, but will be later for those with a zero hour.
